Photography teaches students the nuances of composition and lighting, while computer graphics skills enable them to design and manipulate visuals using software tools. Additionally, audio/video production equips students with skills in filming, editing, and producing multimedia content such as podcasts and social media content, fostering a deeper understanding of media creation and communication in our digital age. This option is designed to inspire creativity but also nurture critical thinking and technical proficiency.
